ESSENTIALS

- □ Backpack (internal or external frame) *
- □ Sleeping bag (0 degrees or colder. Mummy bag is best)
- Raingear
- □ Water bottle (with water!)
- □ Hiking boots/shoes
- □ Fork, Knife, and Spoon
- □ Dish or bowl (plastic Cool Whip container works)
- □ Cup

disposable eating/drinking utensils are NOT allowed

- Something clean to sleep in
- □ Personal Hygiene supplies
 - o Toothbrush, toothpaste
 - Soap, towel or Handiwipes
- Underwear (thermal underwear)
- □ Socks (wool socks, 4 pair)
- Change of clothes
- □ Windbreaker, jacket or sweatshirt (depending on weather)
- Boy Scout Handbook & pen (so you can get signed-off)
- □ Flashlight & batteries
- □ Hat scarf, mittens/gloves
- □ -20degree or colder, waterproof boots
- Emergency blanket

Uniforms are worn when requested and for all District/Council events

NICE TO HAVE

- Sleeping pad/air mattress or quilt to sleep on
- Small pillow
- Hand and Toe Warmers
- Personal first aid kit (see Second Class Scout Requirements)
- Pocket/Jack knife-**Totin Chip** required to carry a knife & regulation knifes only
- Folding camp stool/chair
- Blistex/Chapstick
- Extra socks, gloves, mittens

Items in red are necessary for winter camping

FORBIDDEN ITEMS

- Electronic games like GameBoy, etc....
- Radio
- MP3, iPod, Walkman, etc...
- Sheath knife
- Axe
- Hatchet
- Lighter
