

# Troop Mobilization Plan

In the Event of a troop mobilization:

Person who is informed of mobilization (Police/Fire chief, other adult) contacts SM

SM contacts SPL and one ASM

SPL contacts ASPL and VPL

ASPL contacts two "middle" PLs

PLs contact their APLs and one scout in their patrol

APLs contact rest of patrol

VPL contacts his AVPL and a member of his patrol

AVPL contacts rest of patrol

ASM contacts youngest PL (+ parent) and Committee Chair

Youngest PL (+ parent) contacts his APL and one scout in his patrol

APL contacts the rest of the patrol

Committee Chair contacts Committee

- (1) Once the PL and APL have contacted everyone in their patrol, they are to call the person who contacted them (i.e. SPL, ASPL or ASM). These three leaders will then contact to the SM with a list of all scouts who have responded.
- (2) If a person who you are supposed to call does not respond, you should call the two people that they were supposed to call and inform them.
- (3) Each scout is required to keep his profile on scoutlander updated with his most recent contact information (including home and mobile phone #, if applicable)
- (4) Committee Members and Adult Leaders are required to keep their profile on scoutlander updated with their most recent contact information (including home, work and mobile phone #, if applicable)
- (5) Parents are required to keep their profile on scoutlander updated with their most recent contact information (including home, work and mobile phone #, if applicable)
- (6) Each Scouting family should have an updated list of all phone numbers and other information about at least all patrol members and troop leaders
- (7) Each Scout is required to have a reflective vest or other similarly visible item of clothing on their person at all times during a troop mobilization
- (8) Each Scout must either (a) remain with a buddy at all times, with at least one of the two having a working mobile phone, (b) remain in their patrol at all times, with at least one scout in the patrol having a working mobile phone, or (c) remain in a group with their parent or two other adults, of which at least one has a working mobile phone.
- (9) All other information (on other tools/clothing/groups/ext.) will be given with the specifics of the actual mobilization that is at hand in mind.
